

Call for applications for position as Board Member

The Board consists of 3-5 committed individuals who together govern the school by setting the strategic direction. The Board also selects, appoints, supports and reviews the head of the school, ensures the availability of financial resources and approves annual budgets. The Board is accountable to the members of the School Association and board members are elected for an initial period of three years. We are now looking to bring two members on board our team for the coming very exciting three years ahead of us.

Requirements

The successful candidates must be able to set aside around three hours a month for board work and be prepared to sit on the board for three years.

We are aiming to have a balanced board setup with members external to the school as well as parents of children at the school.
