- *Andreas is a medical doctor with a background in infectious disease and with a PhD in infection biology. He obtained his medical degree from the Karolinska Institutet in 1997 and where he also defended his PhD thesis in 2001. He joined AZ in 2020 and is currently leading Medical Affairs for Europe & Canada Biopharma at AZ and before that he was heading Medical & Regulatory Affairs for AZ Nordic Cluster.*
